Basic instructions for building a forest baseplate. Go to our classroom materials corner.

Materials you will need:

1. Wooden base for the construction of the model.
2. Pieces of paper, cotton or clay to create trees.
3. Clay or small pieces of wood to make the rocks or curves.
4. Natural materials such as twigs, small pieces of wood or coarse paper to create the planting cover.
5. Twine or brush to stick the ingredients.

Construction steps:

1. **Making the base** : Start by cutting and placing the wooden base.
2. **Tree making** : Make small trees using scraps of paper, cotton or clay. Cut and glue them to your base to represent the density of the forest.
3. **Creating Rocks and Curves , Curved Parts** Use clay or pieces of wood to make small rocks and curves in your model. Glue them to the base appropriately to create natural terrains.
4. **Create a ground cover** : Use natural materials or scraps of paper to add color and texture to the surface of the mock-up that represents the grass or ground cover.
5. **Final details** : Add small details such as small animals, flowers or other plants to complete the natural landscape of the model.

Tips:

- Use quick drying glue to speed up the construction process.
- Make sure to keep the scale and realism of the natural landscape you want to represent.
- You can also use paints or markers to give natural colors to your materials.
